
your dive gear; how to breathe and communicate under water; and how to control your buoyancy under water. The clinic is

Due to the fact that paintball is so popular, advance registration is required. We offer paintball every day during the summer. During a game of paintball, players engage in a competitive, team-based activity where they try to eliminate opponents by hitting them with paint-filled pellets. Each game combines teamwork, movement, strategy and a bit of adrenaline! Generally, we assign a total of 20 to 30 campers to each game. Paintball games run for 3 periods lasting for approx. 2.5 hours. Last summer, our Cayuga campers had the opportunity to compete in a paintball tourney against a local camp, and they had an absolute blast!



# MINI ME DAY

Mini-Me Day is an exhilarating special event at camp! Every two weeks, campers have the opportunity to shadow their favorite Senior Staff member or Counselor. It's a unique day that allows campers to gain insight into the daily responsibilities and leadership skills of camp staff. To take part, campers must submit a ballot explaining why they wish to be the mini-me of their chosen staff member. Campers can also opt to give a speech during lunch to elaborate on their choice. Last summer, campers have shadowed Division Directors, assisting with cabin inspections; followed their favorite Activity Director or Instructor at various activity locations, such as the lake, barn, or climbing wall; and assisted the Evening Activity Directors with future night time activity prep.
